

## Launch of Mural Art Wall and Litter Picking with Adviser at Palms NC



Some 150 residents joined Grassroots Adviser Er. Dr. Lee Bee Wah on 19<sup>th</sup> August 2018, in unveiling a mural art wall depicting the history of the Palms Neighbourhood Committee (NC) in the 1960s. The art work represents and celebrates the rich heritage of the area and is situated in Goodlink Park Pavilion.

A huge traditional pastry was also created, in conjunction with the launch, to represent Gin Thye Cake Shop, which was founded in 1964. The shop in the area continues to sell traditional baked goods, and is a handful of such shops that still exist in Singapore.

The mural is Nee Soon South's third piece of public art initiative. The committee aims to bring more elements of art and heritage to the residents, and hopes to attract photographers and tourists to the area.

Following the launch, residents participated in a litter picking event as part of the programme to promote good habits and a clean environment before enjoying refreshments at the pavilion.
